Qualifications

- A college diploma or Bachelors degree in health or health related field; equivalent relevant work experience will be considered;
- Minimum of 1 year relevant research experience in conducting health research, working with Inuit communities;
- Experience with community-based research approaches, experience in dealing with or knowledge of the Inuit health, experience with quantitative research methods, and experience with community dissemination strategies;
- Fluency in Inuktitut, written and verbal;
- Excellent written, verbal, and interpersonal communication skills;
- Highly organized and detail oriented and able to prioritize and produce work of a consistently high standard;
- Negotiating skills, demonstrated initiative and comfortable with independent decision making and problem solving;
- Ability to work as part of a team and work independently;
- Familiarity with computers, previous experience with computer assisted data entry will be considered an asset
- Thorough knowledge of health research-related office procedures, including the data management and quantitative data entry and
- Commitment to maintain confidentiality of information and records;
- Commitment to maintain research ethics.
